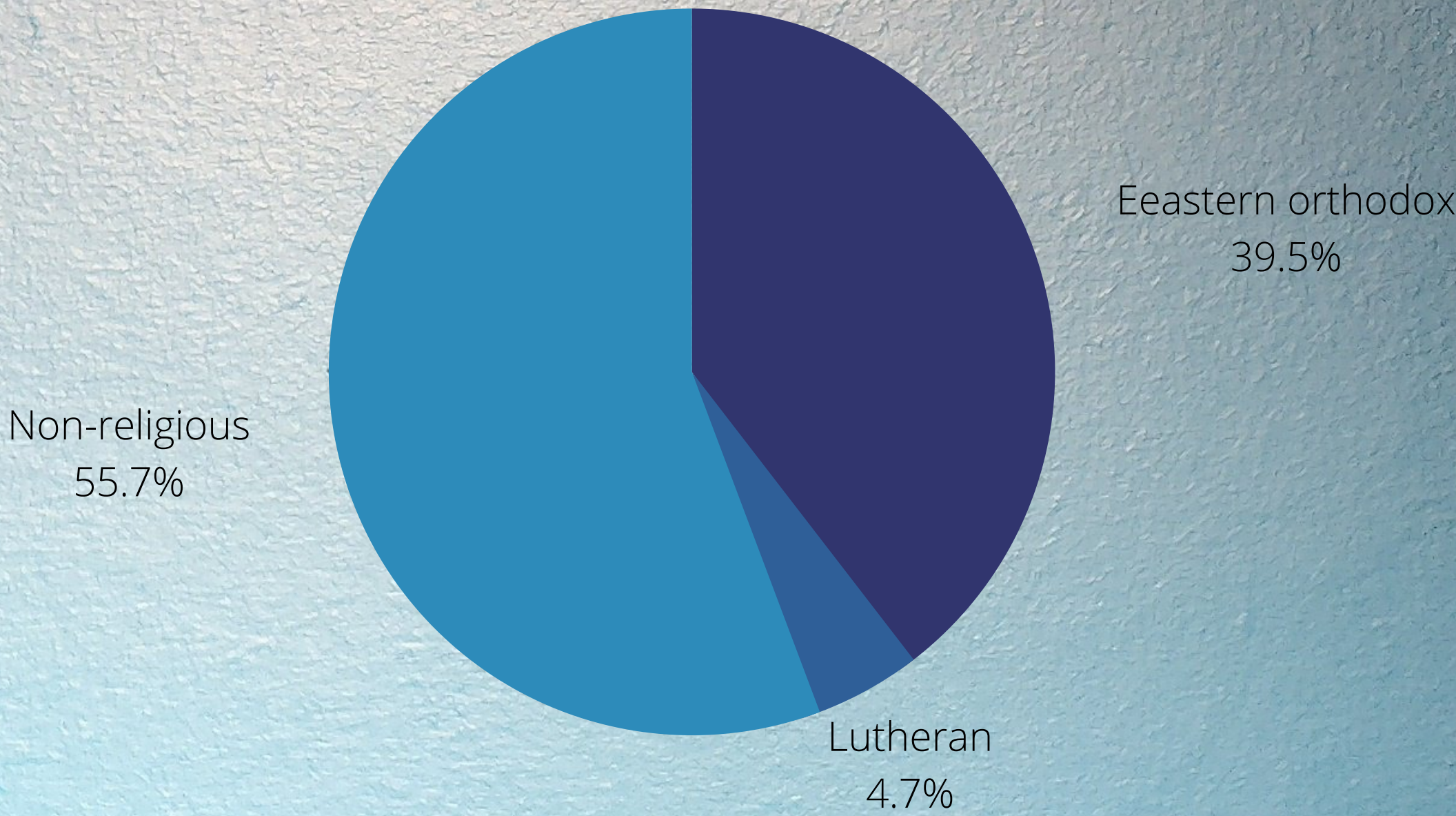
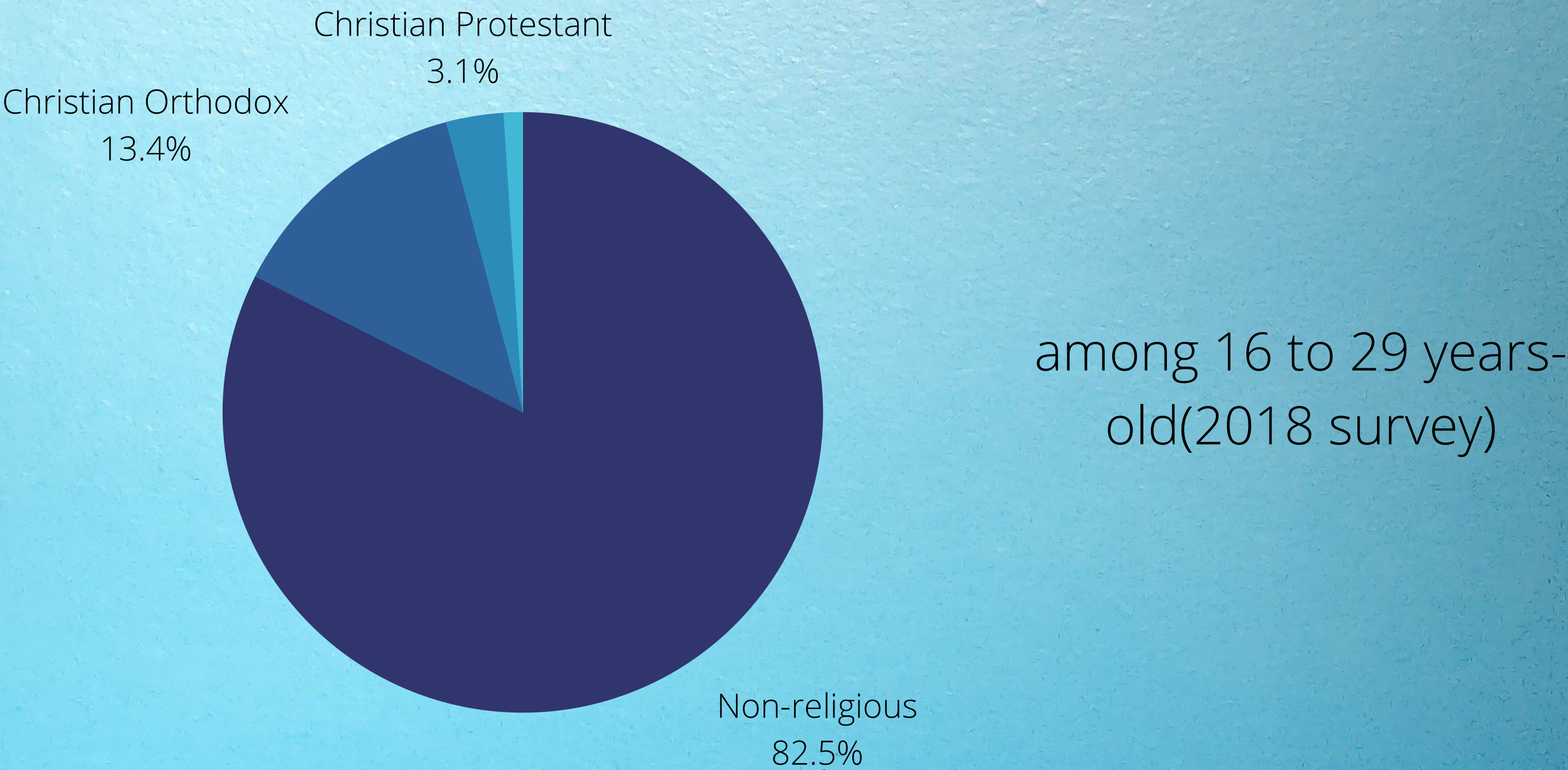


Religion in Estonia

- Estonian people have their own religion called "Native faith" or "Taarausk" in Estonian.
- Estonians aren't very eager to go to church ever, not even on holidays

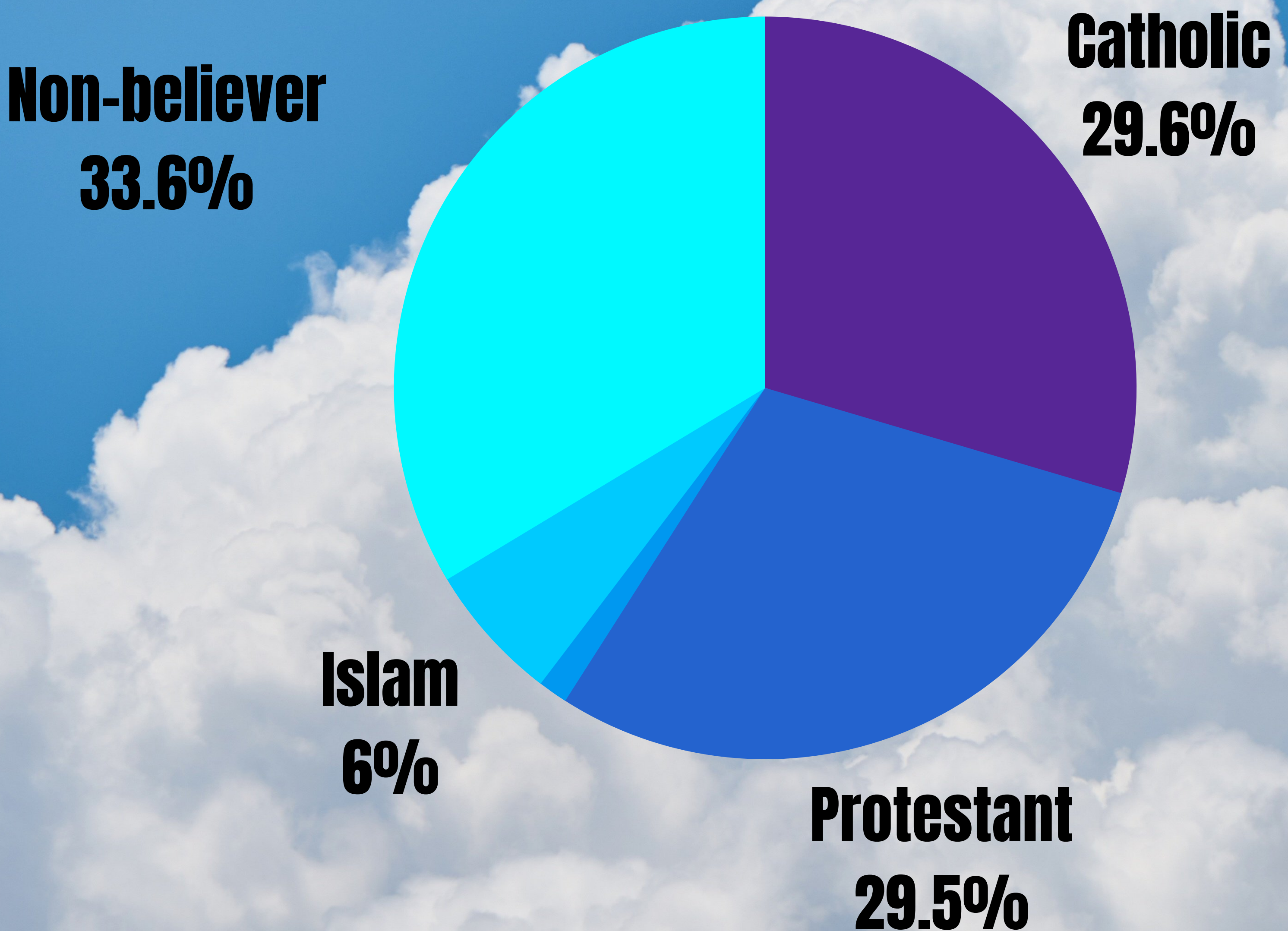


Religion in Estonia(2015)



RELIGION IN GERMANY

- Old German people take religion more seriously than young people
- Very important in German culture
- Before the first world war, 60% off all Germans were Protestant



RELIGION IN SLOVENIA

- The dominant religion in Slovenia is Roman Catholic,
- Other Christian groups having significant followings in the country include Eastern Orthodoxy and Protestantism.
- About 18% of the population are either agnostic or atheist
