Career

- Did his A-levels at a boarding school in England
- Played in groups like Krisma
- Did not do an academic music training
- Was a composer for advertising jingles in 1970
- Was an assistant of Stanley Myers
- Introduced a new way of adding sound to action films

Career

- Became popular for „Rain man“ in 1990
- Was a music producer at „Terminator-Genysis“ in 2015
- Produced suites to produce soundtrack before production ends
- Used ethnic instruments as a style element
